

NCCP CI COACHING COURSE CHALLENGING POLICY

1 BACKGROUND

Synchro BC recognizes that some coaches may choose to challenge the NCCP coaching courses. We would like to remind you that the opportunity to challenge is designed for candidates who have an understanding of the sport and coaching. The candidate who is challenging is doing so because they are confident in their knowledge of the materials that will be covered in the course.

2 WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The following coaches are eligible to challenge the NCCP Competition Introduction Course:

- a) Current member of Synchro BC
- b) Candidates must be 16 years of age at the time of registration
- c) Candidates must have a synchro background, minimum of 5 years as a judge, synchronized athlete or international coach

3 FEES

There will be a \$50.00 registration fee per registration payable to Synchro BC. The fee for challenging the various modules are defined by Synchro Canada and paid directly to the evaluator.

4 PROCEDURE

- a) The candidates must register with Synchro BC (*\$50.00 payable to Synchro BC*)
- b) The candidate must complete the modules in the following order:
 - i. Portfolio (*\$50.00 payable to the evaluator*) & Make Ethical Decision (MED)
The MED is done through the Coaching Association of Canada, please see their website for details (<http://www.coach.ca/>) (*\$85.00 Payable online*)
 - ii. Evaluation at a practice (*\$50.00 payable to the evaluator*)
 - iii. Evaluation at a competition (*\$50.00 payable to the evaluator*)

Please note that the order of the deck evaluations can be changed at the discretion of the evaluator.

Candidates must pass the outcomes in order to move to the next evaluation. If a candidate fails an evaluation they will not be able to continue the process. They will be considered not trained and therefore they will not have deck access at any time. This candidate must register for a course in order to be eligible to coach on deck.

5 MAKE ETHICAL DECISION (MED)

Candidates will have 6 weeks from the time of registration to complete their portfolio and MED. The MED mark should be submitted with the portfolio to the evaluator. The mark must be submitted in order to obtain the portfolio mark. If the 6-week grace period is not met, the candidate must re-register and pay the registration fee again. A candidate can only re-register once. If they do not meet the deadlines the second time then they will need to take a course.

Candidates will have one year to complete their evaluations from the time of registration with Synchro BC. If the one-year period passes, the candidate must re-register. Candidates can only re-register once.

6 CERTIFICATION STATUS

Please note that as per the Coach Certification Policy, candidates will only be considered certified once the Portfolio, MED and on deck evaluations are completed and passed.
